Who is He?

He talks about a coming administration of which he will be the chosen leader

His future agenda:

- * He promises to change the world and make it great again¹
- * He promises a new world order of unity where all will believe the same thing²
- * He promises to ban all other religions but his he is against coexisting with lies³
- * He promises to ban all drunks, witches, murderers and dishonest persons from it⁴
- * He promises to ban all the sexually immoral from it:⁵
 (He defines sexual morality as a marriage union between one man and one woman) ⁶
- * He promises a monarchy, not a democracy (where his rules will be constitutional)
- * He promises that he will be the executive, legislative and judicial branch all in one⁸
- * He promises to be pro-Israel, yet provide equity, righteousness and justice for all nations⁹
- * He promises to be anti religious tradition and anti-"choice" but pro Holy Bible¹⁰
- * He promises a green earth (but his focus will be the heart, not food going into the body) 11
- * He promises prosperity and security for those who work¹²
- * He promises to punish (with fire) all who rebel against his government and leadership¹³
- * He promises disarmament of the military there will be peace and love instead of war¹⁴
- * He promises in the later stage of his administration to build a huge wall around the capital city to keep out the undesirables from illegally entering in and thus ruining it 15

His present policies:

- * He is equal opportunity. *All*, on his terms, may publicly join him to avoid banishment: he is inclusive and non-discriminatory regardless of nationality, class, color or gender¹⁶
- * He graciously invites even rebels to join him now and be freed from punishment¹⁷
- * He promises to absolve all the crimes of those that join him, regardless of how bad¹⁸
- * He promises to give special aid to those that join to help them live and understand ¹⁹

His present club:

- * Those that join him now are admitted to an exclusive club for training for reigning²⁰
- * The club is to follow and trust his ways in the present to equip it for the future²¹
- * The club is given a professionally prepared and inspired manual to teach the plan²²
- * The club is to teach his just policies, tempered with care and love, promoting peace²³
- * The club is taught his wisdom on gender differences in authority and responsibility²⁴
- * The club is taught about loyalty demonstrated in marriage: where the husband is not to divorce his wife (with possibly 1 exception) and remarry. (And the wife is given no authority to divorce her husband nor to remarry while her first husband is still living) 25
- * The club is taught about unity and purity: unity in his way purity by his standards²⁶
- * The club is taught to recruit new members for his coming great administration²⁷
- * The club is promised there will be active opposition (for not all want this new leader) 28
- * The club is taught that counterfeit leaders will imitate his club to mislead for self-gain²⁹
- * The club is to meet often, and together honor this leader and encourage each other³⁰
- * The club is not authorized to set up this new administration. They do look forward with excitement to his set time when their leader will, in power, set up this new government³¹

Who is this unique leader? Let's just say in proclaiming his platform he was crucified. ³² "Who is this King of glory"? The LORD of hosts, he is the king of glory". ³³

References from the Bible alone that identify this Savior and coming King as the Lord Jesus Christ.
